

**ZONING, PLANNING & ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 11, 2011 – 6:30 P.M.**

Meeting called to order 6:30 Committee Present Aldermen: Carl Opper, Scott Logan, Phil Ulmer, Brian Leyden, also present Aldermen Chuck Marzahl, Crystal Musgrove, City Clerk Andy Wells, Mayor Jay Nolan, City Administrator Dave Nelson Chief of Police Dan Kazy-Garey and members of the audience Ken Odling, Lois Odling and Emil Odling.

City Clerk Wells submitted information to the Committee as it relates to the liquor code and a new proposed section for beer gardens. The proposal would be for the beer garden to be an additional certificate attached to the liquor license. The beer garden certificate would be for Class A tavern license, R-1 Restaurant License, and the R-2 Beer and Wine license. Conditions of the beer garden certificate would be set on a case by case basis by the City Council using such conditions as security, lighting, size, fencing and past history of the license owner.

The committee then discussed sidewalk cafes with the same certificate idea with the Class A tavern license, R-1 Restaurant License, and the R-2 Beer and Wine license. Conditions of the beer garden certificate would be set on a case by case basis by the City Council using such conditions as security, lighting, size, fencing and past history of the license owner.

Motion made by Logan, seconded by Leyden to authorize the City Attorney to draft an ordinance concerning beer gardens and sidewalk cafes. All Ayes

Police Chief Kazy-Garey went through a proposal to amend section 20.07 of the municipal code as it relates to a \$20.00 municipal bond fee.

Motion made by Ulmer seconded by Logan to recommend this ordinance with the following change that if the if defendant is found not guilty that the \$20.00 would be returned. All Ayes

Police Chief Kazy-Garey highlighted another proposal for section 1.14 for possession of Cannabis to increase the fine to \$500.00 this would be for 2.5 grams and less. Motion made by Ulmer Seconded by Leyden to adopt this change. All Ayes

The Committee discussed Solicitors on public highways and right of ways. The Committee directed Administrator Nelson to look at additional regulations and report back to committee.
