

PUBLIC PROPERTY MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 8, 2013 – 6:30 P.M.

Chairmen Ulmer called the Public Property Committee meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Public Property Committee members present were Aldermen Ulmer, Marzahl, Clarke and Perkins. Also present were Aldermen Logan and Opper, Mayor Nolan and City Administrator Nelson and audience member Jerry Karr.

DISPOSAL CONTRACT

Administrator Nelson updated the Committee on an e-mail from Veolia whose prices are higher than our current contract with MDC.

Mayor Nolan reported that he had contacted MDC to request a service upgrade to include covered recycle bins to keep recyclables from blowing around. MDC was agreeable to give customers another 35 gallon tote with lid as a recycle bin, but would like a multiple year extension to the existing contract to help offset the initial outlay for the recycling totes.

The Committee discussed the existing contract which does not expire until 12/2013 and the proposed rate sheets. Also discussed was MDC's concern with the abuse of the 35 gallon totes. There was discussion concerning the monthly amount for all users with the consensus of monthly rates to be:

35 Gallon Senior	\$ 6.69
35 Gallon non senior	\$ 11.00
65 Gallon	\$ 14.81
95 Gallon	\$ 21.77

Motion made by Alderman Marzahl seconded by Alderman Clarke to authorize the Mayor negotiate up to an 8 year contract with MDC that includes the 35 gallon recycling tote with lid, one large bulk item pick up per week, and the first year rates to be as noted above. The Mayor will report back to the Chairman of the Committee and either include it on a committee agenda or a full City Council agenda which will be at their discretion. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Motion made by Alderman Perkins seconded by Alderman Clark to adjourn the meeting
