Mayor Nolan called the meeting to order to discuss Section 2(c) (2) Collective Bargaining. Clerk Wells called roll. Aldermen present: Leyden, Marzahl, Ulmer, Musgrove, Clarke, Logan, Perkins and Oppen. Also present were Treasurer Szczap, City Administrator Nelson, Deputy Chief Krause and City Attorney Carlos Arévalo.

Collective Bargaining

Mayor Nolan and Administrator Nelson updated the City Council on the status of the Teamsters Local #700 and FOP Union Negotiations. Contracts with both labor organizations expired April 30, 2011.

FOP

- Negotiations will go to binding federal arbitration with five separate proposals. Areas of impasse are wages, the number of officers that can be off at any one time, cost sharing for retirees' insurance and sick leave conversion.


Teamsters

- There are about 16-17 different areas that haven't been agreed upon. One more meeting will be scheduled with the mediator at which time the City will make a final offer and give notice of a specific date that the contract will be implemented. At that point in time, the Teamsters will have the option to strike according to state statute.
- There is a contingency plan in place to provide essential services in the event of a strike.
