2010 “SPIRIT OF 76” SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Scholarship fund is for encouraging and financially assisting eligible persons to further and pursue their academic or vocational education, training or preparation for their chosen profession, trade, occupation or business.

Those who are eligible for the Scholarship are all High School Seniors residing within the boundaries of Harvard Community Unit School District No. 50. They will be eligible to receive said scholarship regardless of their financial need. Up to \$1,000.00 in scholarship(s) will be awarded.

The application shall be in typewritten form. The application shall be submitted to the City of Harvard on or before Wednesday, April 8th, 2010, addressed to P.O. Box 310, Harvard, IL 60033 or hand delivered to City Hall, 201 W. Diggins St., Harvard. The application shall include the following information:

- A. Biographical information.
- B. Resume of participation in activities, including, but not limited to civic, school, church or other related activities or organizations.
- C. The reason applicant seeks scholarship.
- D. Applicant’s intended use of scholarship.
- E. Names, addresses and phone numbers of three references.

The applicant shall repay said scholarship if:

- 1. The applicant fails to use said funds for the purpose set forth in said application.
- 2. Said applicant terminates, without good cause, his efforts to complete the training set forth in said application.
