

STREETS & ALLEYS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 30, 2005 – 6:00 P.M.

Chairman Berg called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Committee members present were Aldermen Berg, Marzahl, Logan and Perkins. Also present were Mayor Nolan, Aldermen Ulmer and Dikun, Administrator Nelson and Gary Rozwadowski, Smith Engineering Consultants.

Transportation Study

Gary Rozwadowski reviewed the City Wide Transportation Study, Identification of Roadway Collectors and Arterials as prepared by Smith Engineering Consultants, Inc. The general consensus was that the plan should be adopted. Alderman Dikun suggested caution with what is done regarding Jefferson St. because it might not be much of a collector road and not to put much effort into it with respect to widening the street or to go overboard restricting parking.

Moved by Logan, seconded by Marzahl to recommend to the City Council that the Transportation Study be approved as modified with the Garfield/Jefferson St. addition as part of the plan. All ayes. Motion approved four to zero.

Moved by Marzahl, seconded by Logan to adjourn the meeting. All ayes. Motion carried.
