

**STREETS & ALLEYS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES (REVISED)
JANUARY 4, 2006 – 7:00 P.M.**

Chairman Berg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Committee members present were Aldermen Berg, Marzahl, Logan and Perkins. Also present were Mayor Nolan and City Administrator Nelson.

FY06/07 MFT Road Program

The Committee met to clarify street improvements for the FY06/07 MFT Road Program. Administrator Nelson reported on the new technology which utilizes recycled pavement. The cost to use this technology on Front St. from Highway 14 to Diggins St. is just under \$20,000. The pavement may only last 6-7 years, but the cost analysis comparing the expected life of new pavement to the new technology is basically the same. Administrator Nelson recommended trying this technology; if it is successful, it could be used in the future for Northfield Avenue. Moved by Marzahl, seconded by Perkins to recommend to the City Council the following street improvements for the FY06/07 MFT Road Program plus Front Street from Highway 14 to Diggins St. utilizing the new technology. Thompson St. street improvements will be moved to the top of the list for the following year's road program. All ayes. Motion carried.
