

**STREETS & ALLEYS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 3, 2007 – 7:00 P.M.**

Co-Chairman Logan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Committee members present were Aldermen Logan, Szczap and Perkins. Alderman Leyden was absent. Also present were Mayor Nolan and City Administrator Nelson.

No Parking on Galvin Parkway – Tabled

Alderman Logan noted he had brought this to Administrator Nelson for Committee discussion, but asked that discussion be tabled to send notice to residents on Galvin. Moved by Logan, seconded by Perkins to table discussion. All ayes. Motion carried. The Committee will need to set the date for the Committee Meeting a couple weeks in advance so staff has sufficient time to send notification to the affected property owners.

Stop Sign at Klamon/Garfield St.

Alderman Logan reviewed his request for a stop sign where Klamon Street St. T-intersects with Garfield St.; currently there are no stop signs at the intersection. Moved by Logan, seconded by Szczap to recommend to the City Council that a stop sign be placed at Klamon Street westbound at Garfield St. All ayes. Motion carried.

Request to Vacate Portion of Finney Street

City Clerk Wells reviewed his memo regarding a conversation with Dennis Dunn who has requested that the City vacate a portion of Finney Street, from Park towards the tracks. Mr. Dunn and his neighbor would like to split the costs evenly and use their respective portions as driveways. Alderman Perkins expressed concern that he doesn't want it to become a junk car parking lot. After discussion, moved by Logan, seconded by Szczap to recommend to the City Council that Finney Street be vacated from Park Street towards the tracks, maintaining an easement across the entire right-of-way; the property owners on either side to pay all the expenses associated to vacate the roadway, including but not limited to attorney fees, recording fees and survey expenses. All ayes. Motion carried.

At 7:20 p.m., moved by Perkins, seconded by Logan to adjourn the meeting. All ayes. Motion carried.
