Painting Downtown Water Tower

The Committee reviewed the artist's drawings for the artwork/design of the water tower. After discussion, moved by Hay, seconded by Ulmer to paint the downtown water tower without the cow spots and to put "Harvard" on the tower, like the tower in Lion's Park. All ayes. Motion carried.

Sanitary Sewer Bypass Plan

The Committee reviewed the Preliminary Sanitary Sewer Layout for the Northeast Development Area.

Sewer Back-up Policy

The Committee reviewed current policy regarding sewer backups and damage claims as outlined in Administrator Nelson's memo. The general consensus was to maintain the current policy and to continue to process sewer backup damage claims through the City's insurance carrier, who conducts an investigation to determine the extent, if any, of the City's liability, allowing for mayoral discretionary decisions on an individual case basis.
